If there is programming you want to see in the space, skills you want to teach others, administrative duties you want to learn and assist with, or anything relating to Stonewall Youth you want to get involved in; a fellowship might be a good choice for you! Fellowships are long term (quarterly or longer) proposals you contract with Stonewall Youth to create. Fellowships can be almost anything including, but not limited to, support group, outreach, music programming, fundraising, event planning, social media, and administrative.

If it is a project you are passionate about and that will benefit the space, we would love to know about it and assist you in creating your vision! Fellowships are 3 hours of work a week, but can be more if you desire. Past fellowships have included contracting to deep clean the space weekly, leading a workshop series on job readiness skills, assisting in the creation of a protest against “anti-transgender bathroom bills”, and creating a choir during our music Tuesday programming.

There are also plenty of benefits to doing a fellowship outside of passion for the project. The first of these benefits is that Fellowships are paid. If you are accepted into our fellowship program, we provide a monthly stipend for your work. Fellowships also look great on your resume. Additionally, you can ask your fellowship supervisor for a recommendation for future jobs or school.

If you are eager to be a part of a fellowship but are struggling to come up with or outline a project proposal, you can contact our fellowship supervisor, Jax, either during drop in hours or by e-mail at jax@stonewallyouth.org, feel free to make an appointment to outline/review your proposal. **All applications must be turned in by Wednesday Oct. 3rd.**

**all fellows, even if started before October 15th, will need to interview. Interviews are not necessarily to approve or deny fellowships but to get a clear picture of the proposal.

*Start day will be a group session with all fall quarter fellows to review agreements, deadlines, and so they can get to know each other.

Time Commitments

- Your weekly hours for your own individual work (3 hours/week)
- Monthly group fellowship work (1 hour a month)
- Monthly meetings for Youth Council (2 hours a month)

Total: around 15 hours of work per month.

Payment

Payment happens at the end of the month. Payment is a \$160 stipend per month. For fellows just starting Oct 15, You will receive \$80 for the month of October. You will be payed \$160 for November. You will be paid \$80 for December if your project spans that whole time. Your fellowship may end earlier if you chose but you will only receive payment until your work is completed.

Payments happen at the end of the month after evaluating work completed. If work has not been completed on time it does not mean payment will be revoked but it may be withheld until new deadlines are set and followed through. All work must be completed by Wednesday December 12th.

If you are super passionate about working more than 3 hours a week for your individual fellowship work, please let staff know, we can discuss an additional stipend amount from there.

Youth Council Participation

Not only are Fellowship Members expected to do their own individual projects they will also be a part of our Youth Council. Not all Youth Council members are Fellowship members, but all Fellowship members are on Youth Council. Youth Council meets bi-weekly for an hour and a half, this breaks down to roughly 2 hours per month on top of fellow's fellowship hours. Fellowship Proposal Questions

On a separate document please answer the following questions regarding your fellowship proposal. Answers to the questions should be comprehensive, thorough, and finely detailed. Please attach the answers to these questions typed, on a separate paper stapled to the back of this form (excluding the calendar which is already attached below). If you are unable to access a computer to answer these questions you may hand write responses, please do so in pen with clear and easy to read handwriting on lined paper. If you are unable to print your responses yourself, please email to jax@stonewallyouth.org with the subject line “Fall Quarter Fellowship Proposal (your name) Please Print”.

1. Your name, pronouns, e-mail, cell number, birthdate
2. How many hours will you be working weekly for your fellowship? (we ask that fellows work at least three) (excludes time for Youth Council and Group Fellowship Meetings)
3. Please describe in detail your project idea. Your project proposal **MUST** include,
 - A short summary of what your project is (2 sentences at max).
 - A comprehensive plan of what you need to do for your project from start to finish.
 - at least 3 measurable goals! (it is awesome if you have more!)

Measurable goals are goals you set for yourself that are easy to track. For example, if your fellowship was to put on an open mic your three measurable goals could be I’m going to make a poster by the second week, do auditions on the 4th week, and have my open mic the 5th week of the fellowship. These are measurable goals because it is easy to know if the goal has been achieved or not.
 - Use of the calendar below, the calendar spans the whole time of the fellowship. Please write on it a rough estimate of what you will be working on each week. And also place your measurable goals on the calendar.
 - What support you will need from your fellowship supervisor, Jax, or staff as a collective. (Can include, help editing work, getting things printed, text reminders or check ins).
4. A resume of past work. (this can include things outside of formal work, classes you have taken, projects you have done)
